What are the Baden Wine Days?

'Experience, discover and connect' is the motto of the Baden Wine Days, which focus on enjoyment, community and history in this city of culture and spas.

Look forward to a delightful week featuring regional wines, exciting events, and unique experiences at various venues across Baden.

When are the Baden Wine Days?

The Baden Wine Days will take place in Baden from 27 April to 3 May 2026.

Where do the Baden Wine Days take place?

The events are held at selected venues in Baden. You can find the exact venues in the programme.

Will the event take place, whatever the weather?

In principle, the Baden Wine Days will go ahead regardless of the weather. However, in the event of extreme weather conditions, there may be changes to the programme. If in doubt, please check directly with the relevant organiser.

Are the events accessible?

Please contact the organiser directly for detailed information about accessibility.

At what age is participation permitted?

Please contact the relevant organiser directly for this information. While the events are open to everyone in general, the serving and sale of wine to persons under the age of 16 is not permitted.

What is the best way to get there?

We recommend travelling by public transport.

Baden is easily accessible by train (via Baden station) and by various bus routes. All the venues are within walking distance of the station.

To reach the Waldgasthaus Baldegg venue, take bus no. 5 from Baden Station towards Baden, Baldegg (get off at Baldegg).

Are there any travel discounts available for public transport?

Thanks to our transport partners A-Welle and RVBW, you can travel to Baden comfortably and at a reduced rate on public transport. Simply check in via the [FAIRTIQ-App](#) and set off. You'll receive CHF 10 in travel credit for your visit when you use the promo code

WEINDIGIBADEN26.
