A Little History

In **1847**, the «Spanisch-Brötli-Bahn» first ran from Baden to Zurich. Ninety years later, this historic event was celebrated with the «Grosse Badenfahrt» in 1937. The Badenfahrt Committee at the time commissioned the construction of a street version for the occasion. Since then, the «Spanischbrödlbahn» has been considered a symbol of the Badenfahrt.

In **2002**, the city of Baden took over the railway from the Badenfahrt Committee. It commissioned a major overhaul and financed the maintenance, while the City Gymnastics Club was responsible for operating the railway.

In **2017**, the city government decided to discontinue operation and the costly maintenance. As a result, city com baden, the Badenfahrt Association, and the Baden City Gymnastics Club founded the Spanischbrödlbahn Association to preserve and operate the historic street railway.

In **2019**, the Spanischbrödlbahn was transferred to the ownership of the new association for one Swiss franc. With substantial support from private patrons and sponsors, the railway was extensively overhauled and converted to electric propulsion.

Since **2022**, the Spanischbrödlbahn has been tirelessly operating again at private celebrations, corporate and club events, and as a charming ambassador for the culture and spa town of Baden.

Planning an event?

The «Spanischbrödlibahn» offers popular sightseeing tours, creating truly memorable Baden moments.

Three varied tours take you through the city – simply choose the route that suits you best or take advantage of a personal consultation.

Special routes outside of Baden are also available upon request.

The train has a maximum capacity of 28 people and can be rented from March to November.

approx. 60 min.

 Holzbrücke – Wettingerstrasse – Hochbrücke – Weite Gasse –
 Stadtturm – Blinddarm – Stadtturmstrasse – Bruggerstrasse –
 Industriereal – Haselstrasse – Bruggerstrasse – Römerstrasse –
 Parkstrasse – Casinokreisel – Unterer Bahnhofplatz

ROUTE 3

Big Baldegg-Tour

approx. 180 min. including a 60 min. break at Baldegg
 (This route can also be booked individually as a one-way
 or return journey; the duration is reduced accordingly.)

 Schulhausplatz – Kirchweg – Rathausgasse – Obere- und Untere

 Stadtturm – Blinddarm – Stadtturmstrasse – Gstühlstrasse –
 Rütistrasse – Belvédère – Allmend – Münzlishausen – Baldegg

Return journey: Baldegg – Münzlishausen – Allmend – Belvédère –
 Rütistrasse – Gstühlstrasse – Dynamostrasse – Haselstrasse –
 Casinokreisel – Unterer Bahnhofplatz


